Finally after two months of cool rainy weather, you finally have all of your winter damaged areas looking good. Now all you have to worry about is Water, Fertilizer and Mow. STOP!! OK so we have talked about conserving water, fertilizing responsibly, but when is the last time you sharpened your blades? When I ask "How often do you sharpen your mower blades?" most people said once a year when their mower is serviced in the fall. This would be fine if we only mowed our lawn 5-10 times a year. Keeping your blades sharp through out the season is essential for good lawn maintenance. When your lawn is cut with a dull blade it adds insult to injury, leaving many jagged edges at the end of the turf blade which need to heal. The more damaged the ends are, means a higher use of water and nutrients. Not only are you using up the turf's resources, but also the fuel your mower uses increases on the same scale. Every season should begin with two sets of blades, and to interchange them whenever the blade goes dull. If you run your finger across the blade and don't feel an edge, it's time to change. Don't forget to pull the spark plug wire when servicing your machine. Keep your blades sharp and you will reduce your fuel, water and fertilizer use. Good Luck and happy Mowing.
